FAQ's

- **Should fluorescent angiography be done in all cases of bowel obstruction?**
 - No. Fluorescent angiography should only be performed in cases of intestinal obstruction of the small bowel approached by a laparoscopic technique and in which there are doubts about intestinal viability.

- **How to adjust for the dilution and volume of intravenous boluses?**
 - Read the VADEMECUM file

- **When should I take the photo or the short video?**
 - At the time of treatment decision based on the angiographic pattern.

- **Where do I upload the photo or short video?**
 - The photo or short video can be uploaded to the Google Form Online or to the Telegram group by indicating the file with the **center ID** followed by a dash and the **patient ID**
